Psalm 85:6-13; Matthew 7:7-12
"Sealed in Christ"

The "sermon" on Sunday, July 14, was an interaction with the Rev. Cornel Barnett and the congregation. It was called "Sealed in Christ" following the book of that title by John M. Mulder. It's a comprehensive account of the the symbolism of seal of the Presbyterian Church (USA).

The sermonic discussion had congregational members share what hidden objects they saw in the seal. The so-called "objects" reveal the central aspects of our church's identity and theology. Within the seal are found the cross, dove, fish, book, pulpit cup, fire and a triangle.

The discussion was animated and an excellent way of remembering and learning who we are as Presbyterians and Christians.
